## The Charles Pennington Memorial Scholarship

The Charles Pennington Memorial Scholarship was created by Mary Jane Pennington (Charles' sister) to promote the ingenuity "Charlie" possessed. This scholarship will support high school graduates that want to pursue a career in the skilled-trades field. The scholarship will provide funding for post-high school career training/education up through and including an Associate's Degree. Preference will be given to students from Pickford that demonstrates financial need.

The scholarship will be awarded annually to **eligible** students based on the funding available. As assets grow, the Foundation may elect to increase the grant amount or award additional scholarships.

To be eligible, applicants must meet these criteria:

- Applicant must have GED and/or graduated from Pickford High School.
- Preference will be given to students that demonstrate financial need. If the school applicant is attending offers financial aid, the **attached Financial Information Form** must be sent to the school for completion.
- Applicant must be attending a post-high school career training/education school. Scholarship will pay for technical training and up through and including an Associate's Degree.
- Applicant must submit an essay as to why they should receive this scholarship and if they are chosen, how he/she will "Pay It Forward."

Scholarship recipients are eligible to apply for renewal as long as the recipient continues to meet the eligibility requirements and is in good standing at the educational institution the student is attending.
