Who can apply:

Any student graduating from any high school in Chippewa, Luce or Mackinac County or any currently enrolled student at a post-secondary school who graduated from a high school in Chippewa, Luce or Mackinac County.

Criteria:

- Eligible to graduating seniors from Chippewa, Luce or Mackinac County
- Students have to be enrolled in a post-secondary school for agriculture or natural resources. It doesn't have to be a
 degree program. It can be vocational, certificate or training. Students must demonstrate their commitment to the
 agriculture or natural resources career path through community involvement, leadership ability and academic
 achievement.
- Applicants must show commitment to chosen career path in agriculture or natural resources with the exception of parks and recreation or law enforcement
- Minimum GPA of 2.8
